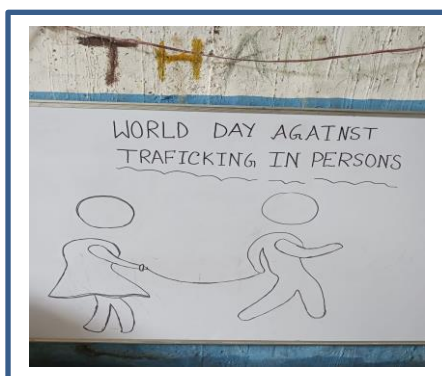
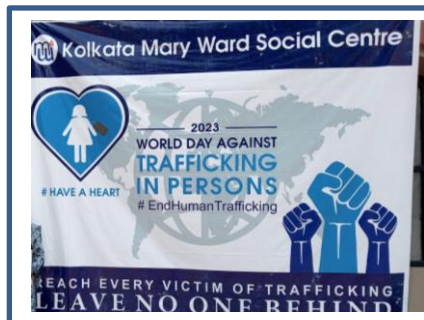
World's Day Against Trafficking In Persons

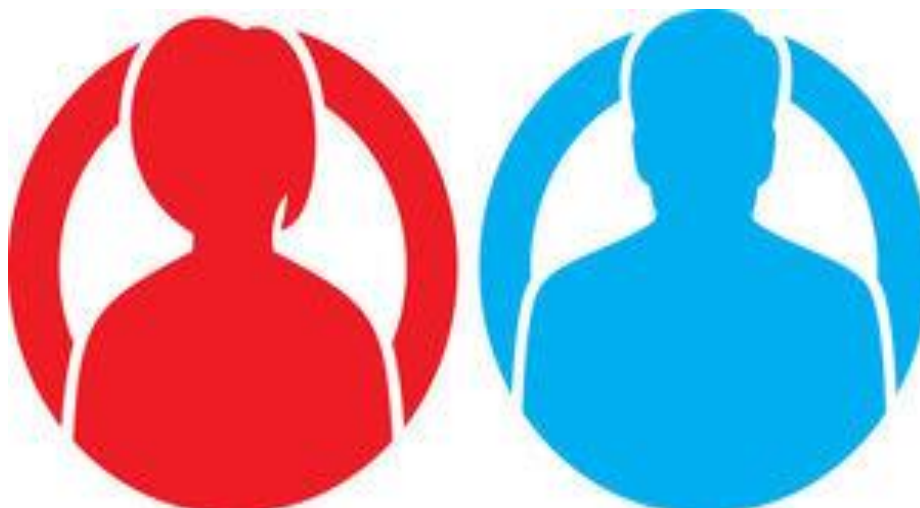

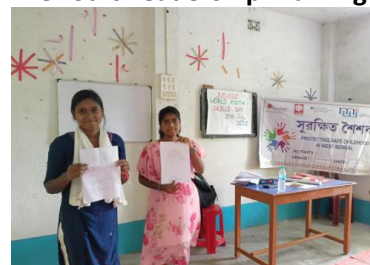

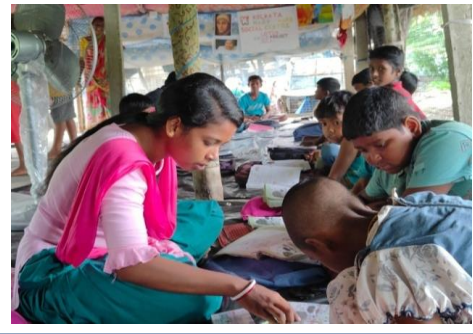
